FINANCIAL AID SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2018

Purpose:

Financial Aid for deserving East End students in Architecture Study. A Jury of AIA Peconic Scholarship Committee Members shall review all entrees and award the Scholarship.

Eligibility:

The Scholarship is available to a graduating high school senior, an undergraduate or a graduate student currently accepted by, or enrolled in an accredited school of architecture. The student must have graduated from an east end high school in the Township of Riverhead, Southold, Shelter Island, East Hampton, or Southampton. If the applicant is awarded a scholarship, he/she is strongly encouraged to attend the **July 12th** AIA Peconic Dinner Meeting to accept the award. This will be held at the Southampton Historical Museum and will be our annual Scholarship Picnic

A student may apply each year up to four years, and may also apply for the separate Merit Scholarship. If applying for both Scholarships, please send each Application Form with separate Statements, but only one of each attachment (Portfolio, Resume, Letters of Recommendation, and Digital Portfolio).

Awards: minimum \$750 up to \$4,500

Application: (if not complete, the application will not be considered)

Provide each of the following:

- Scholarship Application Form
- Portfolio – two to five 8 ½ x 11 drawings or photos of current work.
- A digital record of the entire portfolio; each file should be preceded by YOUR name, i.e. *Smith.image3.jpg* or *Smith.image2.jpg*. No additional description is necessary in each file name.
- Statement in 500 words or less outline how this award would benefit you.
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae
- Two Letters of Recommendation
- A letter from your School's Financial Aid Office verifying need of financial aid.
- A self-addressed, pre-stamped envelope if you would like your portfolio and supporting material returned.
