Prof. Patrick J. Quinn, FAIA, had a paper accepted for the 2017 Annual Meeting in Glasgow of the Society of Architectural Historians. On June 9th, 2017 he presented his paper as one of four speakers at the session on MEDIEVAL VERNACULAR ARCHITECTURE. The session was chaired by Alexander Harper of Princeton University. Prof. Quinn's paper was entitled: "Connections and Intersections in Vernacular Architecture of Mount Athos".

Besides being FAIA, Prof Quinn is a member of the Society of Architectural Historians, a Fellow of the American Academy in Rome and a Fellow of the Royal Society for Arts.
