As one of two Co-Directors of Next Generation Learning Challenges (NGLC), Andrew Calkins helps to lead a national effort to fundamentally reimagine and transform K-12 public education in the U.S. NGLC seeks to dramatically lift and transform student outcomes by helping to spur the development of next gen learning: equitable, student-centered, personalized, competency-based, experiential, and tech-enabled, organized around richer, deeper definitions of student success. Since 2010, NGLC's non-profit grantmaking has invested \$100 million in innovations and whole-school models designed by educators incorporating those principles. In recent years, NGLC has focused on Transformation Design (TD) – the art and science of catalyzing equitable, transformational change in K-12 public education.
